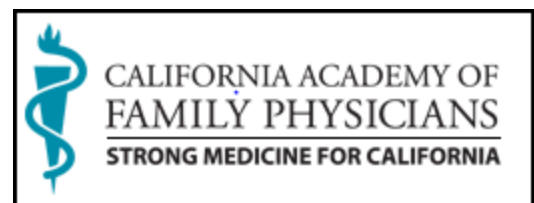


The Future of Primary Care in Sonoma County
