Due to our recent growth and expansion, we seek an on site Medical Director for our San Rafael clinic location. Reporting to the Chief Medical Officer, the Site Medical Director provides guidance, direction and clinical staff oversight to the MCC San Rafael Clinic's medical staff concerning all aspects of primary care. Reviews and maintains medical standards which assure the quality of medical services provided to all patients treated at the clinic.

Oversight Responsibilities

- Participates in provider meetings, QA meetings, Center Leadership Team meetings and other professional activities as requested by the Chief Medical Officer.
- Supervises and supports licensed clinicians through goal setting, coaching, and mentoring. Provide support for quality initiatives.
- Participates and/or leads medical center projects that improve access and quality of care.
- Assists CMO with interviews, hires, and orientation of licensed clinical providers.
- Objectively evaluates and documents performance of providers and escalates to CMO when need for corrective action is deemed appropriate.
- Leads / participates, as appropriate, in collaborative team approaches to developing and enhancing an integrated system of care.
- Assists in the development and implementation of medical office or administrative policies related to the delivery of care.

Clinical Duties

- Provides for the diagnosis, treatment and follow up of health center patients within the scope of his/her license to practice medicine.
- Provides back-up for mid-level providers on site, or by phone during the day or after hours.

Requirements:

Graduate of an accredited medical school. Board certified MD or DO with current California License and DEA certificate. Three or more years experience providing primary care in a family practice setting preferred. Demonstrated clinical skills. Computer skills required. Current BLS certification. Bilingual (Spanish/English) skills preferred. Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal; Sensitive to the needs and situations of a multi-cultural population from a variety of income levels.
