

Family Practice Physician Position Announcement

Full-time Family Practice Physician needed for a growing community health center (part-time position would be considered). The Family Practice Physician will provide direct outpatient care and work collaboratively with two other family practice physicians, as well as our mid-level clinicians and specialists. The physician will maintain hospital privileges, currently for daytime coverage of the newborn nursery with occasional C-section attendance during the workweek. Providing other aspects of inpatient family medicine is negotiable. We seek a bilingual (English/Spanish), board-certified/board-eligible candidate with enthusiasm for community health and quality improvement initiatives and respect for our multicultural patient population and staff. Experience with community-oriented primary care and/or Health Disparity Collaboratives ideal. We offer a competitive salary, an attractive benefits package, and a very desirable location.

The Sonoma Valley Community Health Center is a federally-qualified health center that is committed to providing affordable, accessible and quality health care, regardless of a client's ability to pay. Our Health Center provides medical care and preventative services to people of all ages: newborns, children, teenagers, childbearing women, adults and the elderly. We are the only "safety net" provider serving the residents of the Sonoma Valley and the only primary care provider in Sonoma Valley currently accepting Medi-Cal and uninsured patients. We are located in the town of Sonoma, approximately 45 minutes from San Francisco.

We provide a comprehensive array of primary care services for infants through adults, offer extended day and evening hours, and are open 6 days per week. Services for infants, children and adolescents include routine examinations, immunizations, school physicals, urgent care, and the diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic illness. Services for women include family planning, gynecological examinations and comprehensive pre and post natal care. Women's services also include education and support in nutrition, health education and wellness prevention and psycho-social support. Services to adults and the elderly include diagnosis and treatment of acute illnesses, ongoing management of chronic conditions, routine examinations, insurance and DMV driver's license physicals, mental health services, and diabetic education.
