PIP Project Update (Danielle Oryn)

- No change to the four clinical measure definitions for 2018 reporting
- Continue to following UDS definitions (while still keeping the HTN JNC8 thresholds)
- Measurement period for Colorectal Cancer Screening will be a rolling year, like the other measures. This begins with the Q4 2017 measurement period and continues into 2018

PIP Reporting in January

- Q4 2017 reporting in January 2018.
- Use the same instructions document “Validating and Reporting the Performance Improvement Project (PIP) Clinical Measures [Version 6]” as you have been using all year
- There will be an updated PIP instruction manual for BridgeIT released in February 2018

Heckman UDS Instruction Manual

- Normally, RCHC health centers use the Heckman reports for the financial and demographic tables and the RCHC reports for the clinical tables
- These instructions also contain clinical reports, so do not get confused. Some reports have different assumptions and require different set-up

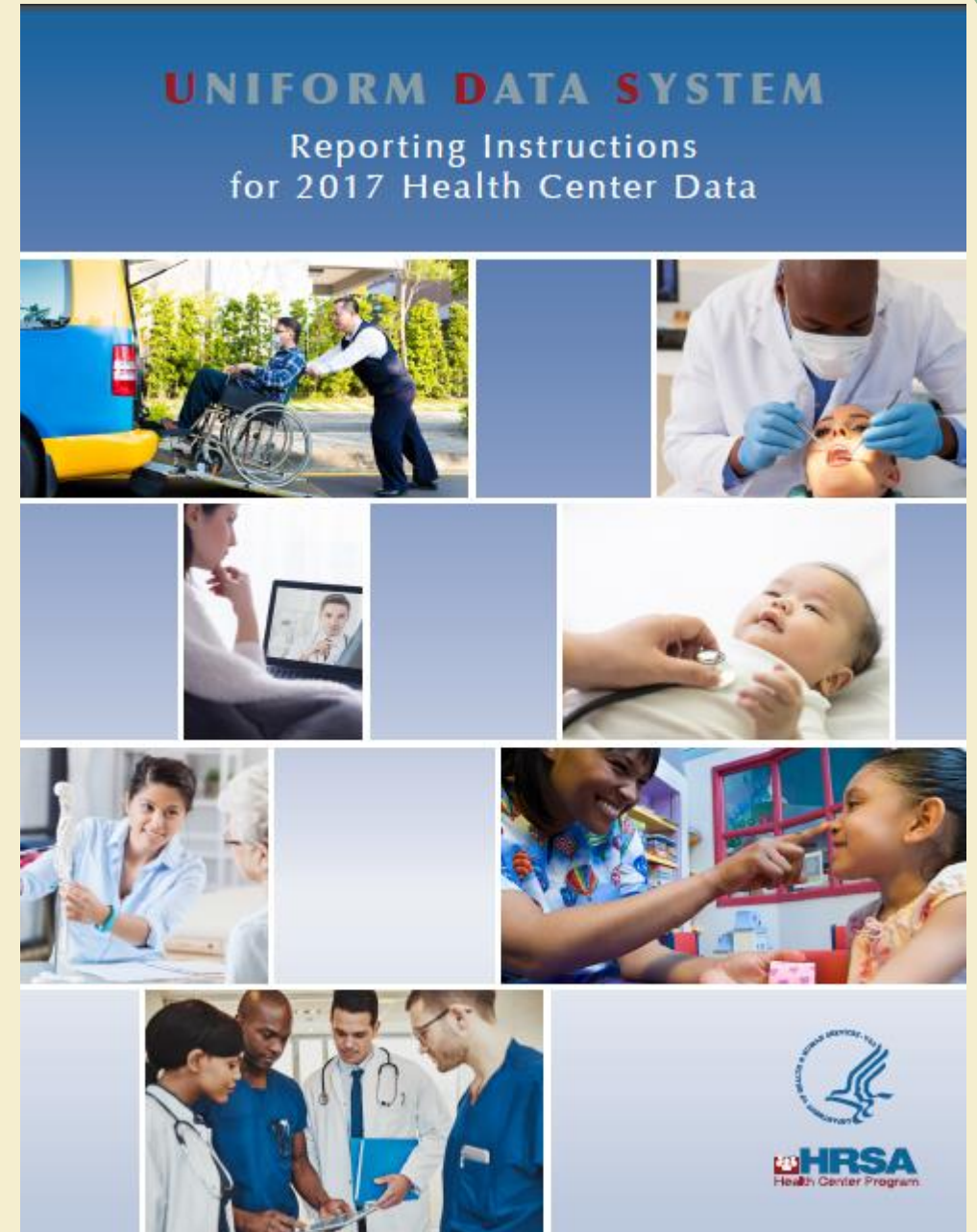

QIP Update

- Currently in the transition period in order to synch the reporting year with the calendar year
- The measurement period is 1/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
- All the measures are the same as what you reported last Summer. Use the same BridgeIT QIP instructions.

2018 QIP BridgeIT Update

- In February, there will likely be new versions of the BridgeIT Annual Clinical Report Set released for 2018 measure definitions.
- QIP has some new measures (e.g., Immunizations for Adolescents) and has updated some technical specifications on other measures
- A new 2018 QIP BridgeIT instruction manual will also be released
- More detail in the February or March Data Group webinar

ACO Update

- Scheduled for December:
 1. Possibly three new versions of BridgeIT reports. These are exclusively ACO-specific reports (e.g., Depression Remission at Twelve Months)
 2. A new BridgeIT ACO Instruction Manual will be released
- Preparation for reporting in January. Data will be entered into the unduplicated patient template supplied by CMS.
- An e-mail to the health centers participating in the ACO will be sent from RCHC detailing all the changes
