



**Addendum to 2020 PIP Program Document  
May 22, 2020**

Quarter 2 of 2020 measures were revised due to significant operational changes caused by the COVID emergency. For quarters 3 and 4, 2020, RCHN will transition back to the clinical measures as designed for the 2020 program year. RCHN anticipates a significant ongoing impact in the performance on the measures due to the change from primarily in-person care to primarily telehealth. For that reason, RCHN will make adjustments to the clinical measure targets, relative improvement, and the transition of care measure. All program elements not addressed in this document will revert to the original 2020 program document as used for quarter 1. Due to COVID 19 and the changing environment around clinical appointments, RCHN will review the Q3 data in case any further adjustments are needed.

### Clinical Quality Measures

The following Clinical Quality measures will return for quarter three with revised targets as in the table below:

1. Blood Pressure Control
2. Blood Sugar (A1c) Control in Patients with Diabetes
3. Colon Cancer Screening
4. Well Child Care At 15 Months

## Payment:

### Relative improvement points

At the end of Q4, health centers ending the reporting year at 70 - 89% will be able to earn additional funds if the health center achieves >10% relative improvement in any one clinical measure. Qualified health centers that achieve the improvement threshold will receive 50% of the funds in reserve for that health center.

### Calculation for Well-Child Visits:

$$\frac{(\text{Fourth quarter 2020 performance}) - (\text{First quarter 2020 performance})}{100 - (\text{First quarter 2020 performance})}$$

### Calculation for Hypertension: Blood Pressure Control, Blood Sugar (A1c) Control in Patients with Diabetes, or Colon Cancer Screening

$$\frac{(\text{Current year performance}) - (\text{previous year performance})}{100 - (\text{previous year performance})}$$

## Care Management Measure
